Jessica Linton - Senior Biologist and Project Manager at Natural Resource Solutions Inc.

Jessica Linton is responsible for the oversight of the Species at Risk Sector, managing a wide range of projects that encompass natural area inventories, scientific research, recovery planning and impact assessments. She is a member of the Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada (COSEWIC) Invertebrate species Specialist Subcommittee and Chair of the Ontario Butterfly Species at Risk Recovery Team.

Jessica will provide an overview of the work the Ontario Butterfly Species at Risk Recovery Team has been doing since the filming of "Butterflies on the Brink: the story of the mottled duskywing". This will include an update on the mottled duskywing reintroduction program at Pinery Provincial Park, a new reintroduction program in Norfolk County, and other projects and species the team is focusing efforts on, including the reintroductions of Frosted Elfin back to Canada after its extirpation in the late 1980s.
